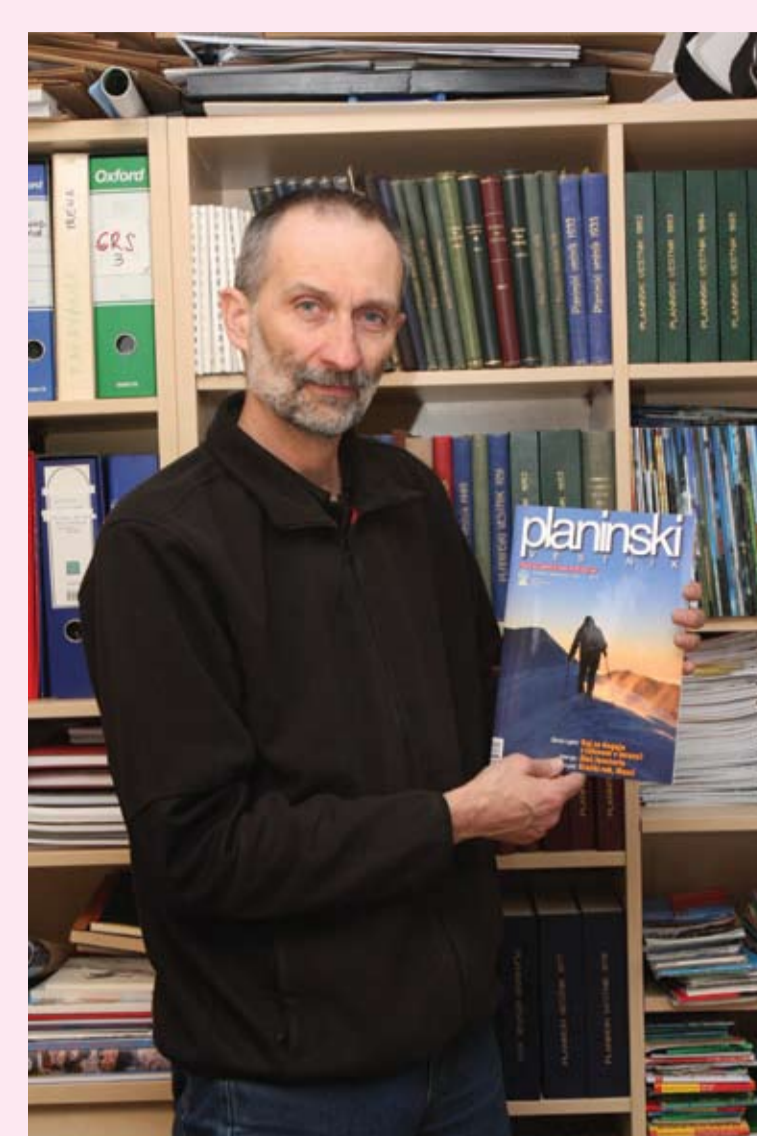


Planinski vestnik. Ali ga res poznamo? Planinski vestnik. Do we really know it?

With over 110 continuous years in publication, Planinski vestnik (The Alpine Journal), Slovenia's oldest monthly journal, has been attracting mountain lovers for generations, since the time of Jakob Aljaž. Planinski vestnik took its readers to the top of Triglav during the construction of the Aljaž Turret. Through the journal's articles, the readers celebrated the opening of the first mountain hut on Kredarica, learned about new climb routes, and admired the courage of Slovenian alpinists - first in domestic mountains, and later, when the time was right, during their attempts at conquering the highest peaks of the world. Planinski vestnik celebrated the historical milestones of mountaineering, and commemorated its saddest moments.

The mission of Planinski vestnik

The journal was first published in 1895 by the Slovenian Mountaineering Society (Slovensko planinsko društvo). In the years when the identity of the nation was put to a test, Planinski vestnik was an indispensable tool in promoting the Society's connecting, educational, and informative role among its members. The journal held a special place in the hearts of all people who helped to shape and spread the mountaineering culture at the time. Today we can say that Planinski vestnik features the complete historical archive of mountaineering in Slovenia.
