ERA conference in Hässleholm

The 47th ERA conference was held 8 -10/9 2016 in Hässleholm, Sweden. The participants had an opportunity to discover a little part of the Skåne region (Hovdala castle and its surroundings).

The delegates welcomed a new member organisation from France: Comité régional de Lorraine de randonnée.

The delegates approved a resolution concerning "Access to nature". This resolution is available on the ERA website

(ERA/Policies) and distributed to all ERA member organisations.

The president Lis Nielsen presented two new ERA partners: Tenerife Walking Festival and Gran Canaria Walking Festival. It was decided that the ERA conference in 2020 will be in Catalonia, Spain.

Know-how sessions in Hässleholm

6 Know-how sessions were held during the ERA conference in Hässleholm.

Armand Ducornet discussed with delegates about the Leading Quality Trails. Aloys Steppuhn presented the last version of the Resolution "Access to nature", prepared for an approval at the General Meeting on the next day. Lis Nielsen introduced all delegates to the EU program "#beActive" (European Week of Sport). Aloys Steppuhn, Armand Ducornet and Boris Mičić

led a discussion concerning the the future ERA directions. The results of this discussion will be revised at the Presidium meeting in 01/2017 and offered for a next discussion at the ERA conference in 2017 again. The "Theme walks" in Denmark were presented by Steen Kobberø-Hansen. Alison Mitchell informed about Medal Routes, a project of the Ramblers Scotland. Mikael Kluge from the HI-Story company in Malmø presented the app "Vandra i Skåne".



EURORANDO 2016 - Skåne

The EURORANDO 2016 event was held in Skåne, Sweden from 10 - 17 Sept. 2016. Svenska Turistföreningen, Event in Skåne AB, Region Skåne and Helsingborg city, together with local communities and 400 volunteers had prepared 80 different walks evening activities and bus tours. The budget for the whole arrangement was on 3,5 mill SEK.



The Kullaleden, which is also certified by ERA as a Leading Quality Trail – Best of Europe, was the most popular walking destination during the whole event. The region was crowned with sunshine and unusually warm weather. 3,000 participants from 24 European countries spent their energy to walk more than 100,000 kms in total. But more than 100 participants also profited of the train&bus card to use the regional public transportation, whose logistics is on a very high level. 
EURORANDO 2016 - Europe

The ERA office is still collecting the data of the walks held in Europe in 2015 and 2016. 18 countries participated in the ERA event by more than 800 walks. We estimate that 70,000 walkers attended. ERA organisations are requested to send the missing data to the ERA office by the December 2016 to confirm the estimated numbers. The final result will be published in January 2017.

The 48th ERA Conference will take place the 28/9-1/10 2017 in Romania, in the city of Braşov. The program, the inscription form and FAQs will be available from February 2017 on the ERA website. The Tenerife Walking Festival will take place from May 23th to 27th 2017. This is a Festival open to nature lovers from all over the world. The Festival combines daily hikes along some of the natural places of the Island with a program of cultural, social and gastronomic activities. Tenerife is a well-known tourist destination in Europe, receiving millions of visitors every year who come to experience its countless attractions. Tenerife's varied landscape and spring temperature (with an average temperature of 23 degrees centigrade) make it an ideal destination to go hiking, with over 1,500 kilometres of trails. Apart from hiking, the festival will let share experiences at the participants' meeting point.

The festival features 20 different hikes or rambles to go on alternate days. Thus, you will be able to join the hikes you find more interesting and attractive. A professional guiding service will be provided. The hikes fall into three categories: coastal, volcanic and forest hikes.
