EURORANDO 2016

The ERA presidium has completed their final evaluation of Eurorando at its meeting in Prague at the end of January 2017.

Walks:

The Eurorando walks were introduced in 2011 and were from the beginning a real pan-European event.

From September 2010 to September 2011 18 MOs organised more than 380 walks. KCT from Czech Republic alone did 168 walks.

Statistics shows that more than 62,000 walkers participated in a Eurorando walk. Several walks even had participants from several countries. The biggest event was in Slovenia with more than 3,000 participants.

The aim for Eurorando 2016 walks was to 500 walks and 100,000 participants.

But the results looked very different: many more walks, more MOs involved and less number of participants.

The MOs, who decided to participate in the walks, have done a great promotion of the event and the coordinators have played an important role to collect data.

Smaller organisations have decided to participate and used the walks to show their international connections with a big success.

I think we can conclude that the Eurorando walks have been a great success and the aims of ERA to encourage closer cooperation among European walkers have been fulfilled.








Final week:

The region was crowned with sunshine and unusually warm weather. All visitors got the best introduction to walking in Skåne.

It was a good week – well organised (despite the problems with bus and lunch packages). The host presented their region and traditions in a charming way.

Eurorando is an opportunity to meet other walkers and discover a new part of Europe. Traditions in Europe are more different - as a majority of the walkers think they are – but problems are here to be solved (and communication is the most important tools).

"Expectations" from participants:

- It is like home just bigger and better
- We want to walk and experience a lot of the landscape
- We want to be mainly tourists and take many pictures
- The rules for walking, safety, waymarking is like home
- It is not too expensive
- The local guides can speak all languages and know everything
- We don't need to ask for everything when we book walks, transportation and accommodation – they know what we want (like home)
- We don't need to read everything in"small letters".

We have learned:

- ERA must be more visible
- The opening and closing ceremony must last longer and have a bigger ERA-content
- Everything must be in 3 languages (+ host language)
- The area for walks and accommodation must not be too big
- A central meeting place open all evenings can be good
- Walking in large groups (100-400 persons) with more nationalities is fine
- A parade at the end might be a good idea
- We want more than 3,000 participants
- The local MO must be visible and very active at the event

EURORANDO 2021

The presidium at its meeting in January 2017 approved the organisation of the EURORANDO 2021. The whole event will be split into two parts – Eurorando walks in Europe, organised by the member organisations during the whole year, and the Eurorando final week. The proposed theme is "Friendship". The list of conditions for the host in 2021 is available on the ERA website or on request in the ERA office. Deadline for bids is the 1 August 2017. Then the host of EURORANDO 2021 will be decided shortly after the ERA conference in Romania.









European Week of Sport - #beActive

ERA – as a partner with the European Commission – encourages the member organisations to take part in this great pan-European event. It takes place annually from 23-30 September. If you have some walks



during that week, just use them for this programme. You must contact your national coordinator to be registered.

It is important that the walkers show that our sort of physical activity is just as valuable as all other sorts of sports. Outdoor activity is one of the official themes for the week. You can find more information at: http://ec.europa.eu/sport/week/

Tenerife is a well-known tourist destination in Europe, receiving millions of visitors every year who come to experience its countless attractions. Apart from hiking, the festival will let share experiences at the participants' meeting point.



The festival features 20 different hikes or rambles to go on alternate days. Thus, you will be able to join the hikes you find more interesting and attractive. A professional guiding service will be provided. The hikes fall into three categories: coastal, volcanic and forest hikes.

ERA conference 2017 in Brasov



Frank Schlinzig, the former chairman of the ERA Path commission from the years 1997 – 2007 and the representive of the Deutscher Wanderverband, passed away the 29 December 2016. He maintained the network of trails on the regional, German and Europe-wide level for many, many years.

Hubert Yseboodt, the ERA honorary President and the representant of the Grote Routepaden, passed away on 10 January 2017. He gave his heart fully to ERA, where he was active for 36 years in total, 23 years of it he worked in the Presidium and between 1994 - 1997 he carried out the position of the ERA President.
